This year, the National Bee Unit in Wales is offering beekeepers the opportunity to 'drop in' to one of its new advice and information surgeries. Hosted by local associations but open to all beekeepers, the surgeries will take place on a series of Saturday afternoons at venues across Wales during the summer.

Local beekeepers are invited to drop in, any time between 2 and 5pm, in order to:

- *consult members of the Welsh bee inspectorate on the disease threats specific to their bees and apiaries*
- *seek expert advice on their own biosecurity arrangements*
- *develop their knowledge and diagnosis of key pests and disease, with the chance to handle brood disease 'on the comb' and browse specialist information resources*
- *learn about the new threats to their bees posed by exotic pests and diseases.*
